

- First- and second-degree burns












Breaking Down the Benefits



Application Process



Debride the wound bed of slough and necrotic tissue.



Apply powder or gel, covering the entire area of the wound bed and wound margin. Gently push powder or gel into any areas of undermining.



Apply an appropriate secondary dressing.



Reapply a minimum of 2-3 times a week or as necessary.
